Wednesday, Feb. 24- writing test- need 4 monitors

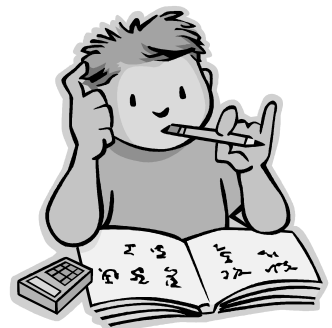
Monday, April 12; Tuesday, April 13; Wednesday, April 14; Thursday, April 15; and Friday, April 16- need 6 test monitors each day

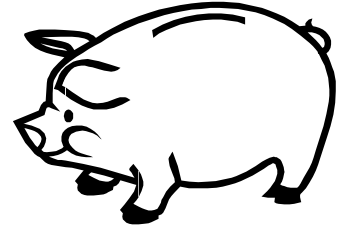
