Extended School Days Started Today

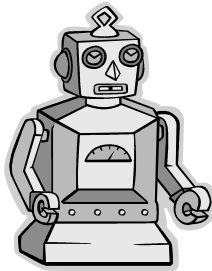

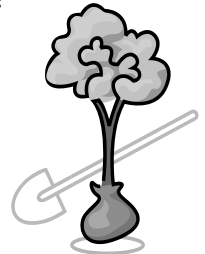
Beach Day a Success
